

and maintenance work includes: Examining equipment, making diagnostic tests to determine nature and extent of work necessary, laying electric circuit cables, conduits, control gears and associated accessories, connecting emergency power generator equipment, providing sound grounding system and ensuring that all facilities electrical systems meets the US Mission safety requirements as required. 45%

Responsible for periodic and other assigned preventive maintenance of residential/office buildings electrical system including servicing and repair of AC equipment, checking distribution board power mains, verify and certify correct fuse rating and loading to various outlets in all work locations, replace blow security light bulbs, adjusting temperature gauges, automatic transfer switches and regulators, checking appliances e.g. washers /dryers, microwaves, water pumps, fridge and freezers etc. Incumbent will also repair/ maintain hand tools and office/shop equipment 40%

Performs tasks in other trade works as assigned i.e. basic non electrical jobs unassisted as qualified by on- the- job training. Provides assistance to other qualified Journeymen mechanics as required. Composite of multi- trade tasks includes plumbing, carpentry, masonry and familiarity with safety practices involving tasks, tools and equipment. 10%

Will perform incidental driving duties to transport tools and equipment and personnel to and from work sites, unskilled labour and non skilled tasks such as cleaning, digging and backfilling, and gardening. 5%

15. QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED FOR EFFECTIVE PERFORMANCE

- a. Education
Completion of secondary school and vocational training or apprenticeship recognized as producing journeyman electrician skills, or equivalent is required.
- b. Prior Work Experience
Three years of journeyman electrician experience is required.
- c. Post Entry Training
On the job
- d. Language Proficiency: List both English and host country language(s) by level and specialization.
Level II English is required.
- e. Knowledge
Must have full journeyman electrician knowledge of established practices and procedures of the electrical trade is required.
- f. Skills and Abilities
Must have the ability to use all tools/equipment and professionally determine extent of damage or problem with the experience it takes to make necessary recommendations for equipment repair or replacement. Must hold valid Ugandan driver's license.
